For those of you that would like to make a real night of it and not have to worry about driving home, the hotel is offering a special 'stop-over' rate of £25 per head which includes breakfast – please contact the hotel directly for this.

MOORINGS & HARBOURS

Please note that it is a condition of our moorings that the boat name and the mooring number (see your invoice from Harbours) is painted clearly on the mooring buff. As we are all probably making a list of jobs that need doing before the season starts, can you please make sure this is added to the list. Please also remember that all moorings must be chain, apart from the last few feet – not all rope.

The Committee continues to work with Jersey Harbours to sort out the moorings waiting list and fill some of the empty spaces with new boats as well as generally improve facilities. Progress is frustratingly slow due mainly to the number of historic issues that have emerged. However, Harbours have made a commitment to a significant number of 'move-ups' and new allocations by the start of the season, so watch this space.

We have also reviewed the list of maintenance issues with Ray Hine from Harbours, and in particular they have promised to attend to the various ground-chain issues very soon. You may have noticed that they have already replaced a couple of ladders and some of the rusty railings amongst other work, so progress is being made. We have also invested in two new sets of strops (one large and one for smaller boats up to 4 tonnes), the current ones having reached the end of their insurable life. If you have noticed anything else that you think needs adding to the list, please contact a member of the committee.

Whilst the majority of members have now paid their subscription, there are still a few to collect.
